

DAY TRIPPING FROM REVELSTOKE

Pack a lunch and enjoy a fun-filled day of discovery!

- 9:00AM** Depart from Revelstoke and head **east** on Trans Canada Hwy #1. Approximately 25 minutes (28km) east of Revelstoke is the impressive **Skunk Cabbage Trail**. This unique wetland experience offers a 1.2km interpretive boardwalk trail and provides great bird watching. Allow 30 minutes to complete the loop.
- 10:00AM** Leave the boardwalk and continue east on the Trans Canada Hwy. As your vehicle climbs towards the 1382-meter summit, enjoy views of the stunning mountain glaciers and keep your eyes peeled for wildlife. The summit is approximately 39km east of the boardwalk.
- 10:45AM** Arrive at the **Rogers Pass Discovery Centre**, located at the summit of Rogers Pass. There are many interesting exhibits located at the summit and you should allow approximately 1 hour to enjoy the attractions. We suggest you:
- Check out the natural history exhibits and displays at the Rogers Pass Discovery Centre.
 - Visit the Memorial Arch.
 - Stroll through the ruins of the Glacier House, abandoned 1890s rail line, and the collapsed snow sheds.
 - Browse through the Friends of Mount Revelstoke & Glacier bookstore.
- 11:45AM** Get back in your car and continue east. Columbia River Safaris is approx. 53km east of the Rogers Pass summit.
- 12:25PM** **Arrive at Columbia River Safaris.** After travelling down a long hill, the Trans Canada bends to the left and you will cross a bridge over the Columbia River. Our turn-off will be your first left hand turn...look for our sign and small road. About 80 meters down the small gravel drive, you will see the parking area.

Come in and enjoy your packed lunch at our picnic area, located behind the Columbia River Discovery Centre.

Please remember that Columbia River Safaris is on Mountain Time (1hr ahead of Pacific Standard Time, ie. Revelstoke). Although you will leave the summit at 11:45pm PST, you will arrive at Columbia River Safaris at 1:25pm MT for your 2:00pm departure.
